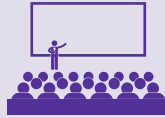

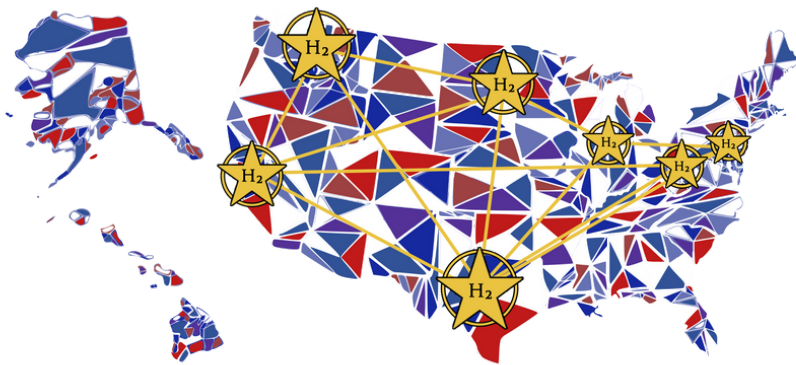

HYDROGEN NATION NETWORK (H₂N²)

An initiative to connect and develop hydrogen hubs across the United States and the global hydrogen economy.

Funding

The Federal Government has invested \$7B in hydrogen hubs across the country, with the potential of another \$15.5 B

H2 Nation Network leverages this foundational investment through additional public and private funding.

Hubs

Each hydrogen hub will be shaped by the region's unique resources and demands. *H2 Nation Network helps identify a region's path forward to creating a hydrogen hub.*

Corridors

Hydrogen fueling must be placed along major travel corridors.

H2 Nation Network strategically plans the placement of fueling infrastructure for vehicles, locomotives, planes, ships, and other equipment.

Policy

Hydrogen policies and incentives need to be developed.

H2 Nation Network ensures that uniform and market enhancing hydrogen policies are developed and implemented the U.S.
